(14 days / 13 nights)

DAY 1 - RIO DE JANEIRO

Meeting and assistance upon arrival in Rio de Janeiro, and transfer to your hotel. Balance of day at leisure.

DAY 2 - RIO DE JANEIRO

After breakfast, morning departure crossing over the traditional residential area of Cosme Velho and disembarking at the Corcovado railroad station to take a train ride through lush forest up to statue of Christ Redeemer, which stands 38 meters high and 710 meters above the city. Return via panoramic road to the Sao Conrado, Leblon, Ipanema and Copacabana Beaches. Rest of the day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 3 - RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast. Day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 4 - RIO DE JANEIRO / IGUAZU

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Iguazú (flight not included). Arrival in Iguazú must to be before 12:00 pm). Arrival and transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon enjoy a walking tour of the Brazilian side of Iguazu Falls for a panoramic view (Entrance Fee included). Stroll around catwalks and admire the beauty and abundance of one of the world's great natural wonders. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 5 - IGUAZU

Breakfast. Full Day Argentinean Falls visiting the upper falls circuit, the down falls circuit and Devil's Throat. The tour includes a trip aboard a gas-propelled train. We recommend you the optional tour Nautical Adventure. Return to your hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 6 - IGUAZU / BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Buenos Aires (flight not included). Arrival and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 7 - BUENOS AIRES

Breakfast. In the morning panoramic city view. This tour gives you the emotion of a multiple Buenos Aires. We will see the symbol of our city: the obelisk. We will visit different squares such as Plaza de Mayo, Plaza San Martín, Plaza Congreso. Avenues like Corrientes, Mayo, 9 de Julio, among others. Historical neighborhoods: La Boca, San Telmo, Montserrat. Elegant neighborhoods such as Palermo and Recoleta, and the most modern: Puerto Madero. Parks such as Lezama and Tres de Febrero. We will also visit financial and commercial areas and a Soccer Stadium. Afternoon at leisure. In the evening, experience one of the true highlights of your tour, a Dinner & Tango Show. The Tango was born in Argentina, and a visit to one of the tango show houses features the best artist and dancers accompanied by traditional Argentine cuisine.

DAY 8 - BUENOS AIRES



Breakfast. Day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 9 - BUENOS AIRES / MONTEVIDEO

Breakfast and transfer to the port to take the Ferryboat to Montevideo. Meeting and assistance upon arrival in Montevideo and transfer to your hotel. Balance of day at leisure.

DAY 10 - MONTEVIDEO

Breakfast. morning city tour of Montevideo, visiting the Old City, Independence and Constitution Squares, The Artigas Monument, The Congress Building, the rose garden of El Prado. Continue to the Obelisk and the famous La Carreta (covered wagon) monument. You will also visit the residential areas and return to your hotel. Afternoon at leisure.

DAY 11 - MONTEVIDEO / SANTIAGO DE CHILE

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Santiago de Chile (flight not included). Arrival and transfer to your hotel. Balance of the day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 12 - SANTIAGO DE CHILE

Breakfast. Today you will embark on a half-day tour of the city. Santiago is a city of contrasts with traditional areas, a civic center and a modern district. The tour includes such highlights as the Club Hipico, a beautiful horse racing track, Cousino Palace, the "La Moneda" government palace, the Pre-Columbian Art Museum, and The Plaza de Armas. Return to your hotel and rest of the day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 13 - SANTIAGO DE CHILE

Breakfast. Day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 14 - SANTIAGO DE CHILE

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight home.
